



Tucson Unified School District (TUSD)




- 47,000 students

- Oldest and largest school district in Southern AZ
- 71.5% qualify for free/reduced meals





Tucson Unified School District (TUSD)

- McKinney-Vento Population 2%
- Primary language is English
- 5 major languages we provide services for:
 - Spanish
 - Arabic
 - Kirundi
 - Somali
 - Swahili
 - Vietnamese
- Due to increases in refugees, also provide language support for Dari and Pashto


National Network of Partnership Schools (NNPS)

- Centers offer the same services and programs
- Funded though Title 1 and Desegregation funds through the school district

- Parent education and computer classes with free childcare and transportation options




