Highlights

- The Network began working with the University of Kansas, which is tasked with completing an evaluation of the impact of Family Resource Centers in Kansas. Data gathering began in March 2024 and sensemaking sessions began in 2026.
- In FY25, the University of Kansas gathered data from 10 FRCs across Kansas and found the following impact:
 - 2,856 Families Served
 - 29,645 Adults & Children Served
 - 5,761 Concrete Supports Distributed to Families
 - 275 Events & Trainings Offered
 - 99 Literature & Early Education Supports Provided
 - 79 Early Childhood Supports Provided
